

Application Note: Cleaning & Maintenance of VOID Loudspeakers with KROME finish

To ensure longevity and pristine appearance of the Void Acoustics' KROME-finished products, please adhere to the following cleaning and maintenance guidelines:

- Do Not Polish:** Do not use any cleaning products such as polishes on the KROME surface, these are usually abrasive and will scratch the surface, possibly reacting and causing staining, or dulling of the finish.
- Gentle Cleaning Only:** Under normal use conditions a soft, non-abrasive cloth for removing dust is all that should be required. Microfiber cloths or cotton towels are ideal for gently removing dust, fingerprints, and other surface residues without damaging the KROME.
- Regular Maintenance:** For best results, remove dust build-up on the KROME surface regularly to prevent buildup of grime or residue.
- Avoid Excessive Moisture:** While it's important to keep the KROME surface clean, avoid excessive moisture or prolonged exposure to water. Wipe away any spills or moisture promptly to prevent water spots, streaks, or potential corrosion.
- Protect from Abrasive Contact:** Be mindful of any objects or surfaces that may come into contact with the KROME finish. Avoid abrasive materials or harsh chemicals that could scratch, react, or damage the surface.
